



Wireless Remotes

- 1. Open the battery compartment of the remote and install a compatible battery.
- 2. Match the dipswitch code on the remote with the dipswitch code on the fan's receiver. The code must match or the fan will not work. Note: Some remotes will have a 5th DIM/ON dipswitch. If your fan is using dimmable bulbs or has a dimmable LED, set the switch to the "DIM" position. If your fan is using non-dimmable bulbs or is not responding to the remote, set the switch to the "ON" position.




Wired Wall Remotes

- 1. Turn off power at the breaker. **
- 2. Unwire and remove the defective switch from the wall box.
- 3. Wire the new wall switch using the owner's manual for refrence.
- 4. Mount the new wall switch and wall plate.
- 5. Restore power from the breaker.

Note: Some wall remotes will require a battery. Check the owner's manual to verify.

Note: If the fan uses a receiver be sure to match the dipswitch code.
