


## Built-In Receiver

- 1. Turn off power at the breaker.
- 2. Carefully bring the fan motor down and remove the top housing.
- 3. Remove the motor's top cover (usual 4-6 screws).
- 4. Unplug the old receiver's 9-pin connector plug.
- 5. Disconnect the old receiver's blue and white wires (will be connected with 1-pin plugs or wire crimps).
- 6. Remove the two screws holding the receiver in place.
- 7. The defective receiver can now be removed.
- 8. Install the new receiver using the diagram below for reference.
- 9. Re-install the entire ceiling fan.
- 10. Lensure the receiver's dipswitch code matches the remote.



## Canopy Receiver

- 1. Turn off power at the breaker. \*\*
- 2. Disassemble the canopy on top of the fan to access the receiver.
- 3. Unwire the defective receiver and remove from the canopy.
- 4. Copy the dipswitch code from the defective receiver onto the replacement receiver.
- 5. Wire the replacement receiver using the owner's manual's diagram.
- 6. Secure the wire nuts with electrical tape.
- 7. Slide the receiver into the hanger bracket with the flat side facing up.
- 8. Re-install the canopy and restore power to the breaker.
- 9. Lensure the receiver's dipswitch code matches the remote.
